



ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS 1993 – 2023 PUBLIC TRANSPORT REGULATION ACT, 2009

TRAFFIC CALMING SCHEME

Municipal District of Ballymote - Tubbercurry

Sligo County Council in exercise of the powers conferred on it under Section 38 of the Road Traffic Act, 1994 and Section 46 of the Public Transport Regulation Act, 2009 hereby gives notice that it has prepared a Scheme for the provision of traffic calming measures at the following location:

Ballinacarrow Village – In the interests of road safety and convenience for all road users, Sligo County Council is proposing to introduce traffic calming measures at the junction of the N17 National Primary Route and the L6108 Local Road in the village of Ballinacarrow. The scheme provides for a raised uncontrolled crossing, tactile paving, increased footway width, tightened junction layout, relocation of an existing traffic calming island, and associated engineering works.

Accordingly, the statutory report will list the persons or bodies who made submissions or observations with respect to the proposed Traffic Calming Scheme in accordance with the regulations of the Road Traffic Act 1994. The submissions will also be included in the minutes of that meeting and consequently will appear on the Council's Website. By making a submission the name of individual or bodies will appear on the statutory report and minutes of the meeting.
