LARGE SCALE STRUCTURE TREES

NB: All trees should be full and well shaped, bark unmarked and have healthy root systems. Planted in same species groups.
All trees to have 2m clear stem.
All trees native or naturalized species

Lines for entire street, no mixing of species. All trees to have 2m clear stem.

Species mix to include the following species:

Birdfoot Trefoil, Black Meddock, Cowslip, Devil's Bit Scabious, Meadow Buttercup, Field Scabious, Hemp Agrimony, Kidney Vetch, Lady's Bedstraw, Lady's Ann lace, Lesser Knapweed, Meadowweet, Mullein, Ox-eye Daisy, Purple Loosestrife, Ragged Robin, Red Campion, Red Clover, Ribwort Plantain, Rough Hawkbit, Sorrel, St Johnswort, Wild Angelica, Wild Carrot, Yarrow, Yellow Agrimony, Yellow Rattle, Teasel and more. Also includes 35% annuals: Corn Marigold, Corn Poppy, Corncockle, Cornflower, Scented Mayweed.

GENERAL PLANTING MIX - Shrubs, Perennials, Hedging, Grasses

NB: Shrubs shall be bushy, well established nursery stock with a good fibrous root system.
They shall be container grown, true to size, name and description as scheduled. Shrubs shall conform to the appropriate British Standards.
Plants shall not be pot bound, nor with roots deformed or restricted.

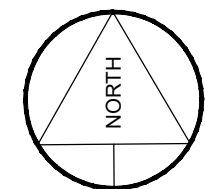
