Having regard to Part XAB of the Planning and Development Act 2000 (as amended) and following an examination of the objective information provided in the “Appropriate Assessment Screening Report prepared by Roughan & O’Donovan dated July 2023”, Sligo County Council, as the Competent Authority, determines that individually or in-combination with other plans or projects, the proposed development would not be likely to have a significant effect on Unshin River SAC or any other European site, in view of the sites’ conservation objectives.
