Phase 2: Options Selection

N4 Active Travel Collooney to Toberbride Scheme & N4 Active Travel Collooney to Castlebaldwin Scheme

Introduction

Sligo County Council, through the Sligo Regional Design Office, are in the early stages of planning the N4 Active Travel Collooney to Toberbride Scheme and the N4 Active Travel Collooney to Castlebaldwin Scheme.

The overarching objective of these Schemes, which are funded by Transport Infrastructure Ireland (TII), is to provide continuous pedestrian and cycle (i.e., Active Travel) facilities from Collooney to Castlebaldwin that will improve safety and accessibility for all. It is envisaged that the Schemes will integrate with the wider Active Travel network including the Sligo Greenway, the SLNCR Greenway, and existing facilities from Toberbride Business Park to Doorly Td, improving local and regional connectivity.

DBFL Consulting Engineers have been appointed by Sligo County Council to provide multi-disciplinary engineering and other specialist services to progress these two Schemes through Phases 2 to 4 of TII's Project Management Guidelines.

What's Happening Now?

Both Schemes are currently at Phase 2, entitled 'Options Selection'. The purpose of Phase 2 is to identify a suitable Study Area and to examine alternative route options to determine a Preferred Option.
